Pursuant to and for the purposes of art. 13 of the GDPR we would like to inform you that the personal data you provide, including those relating to the child whose parental authority you have (and/or legal guardian), will be treated in accordance with the principles of fairness, The Commission has also taken a number of initiatives to improve the quality of the information supplied.

The provision of your data, such as those of the minor, is necessary for the definition of the contractual agreement and for the registration of the minor's stay at the Hostel of the Castle of Santa Severa and to offer the requested services. In addition, your identification data (name, surname, address, etc.) are necessary for the issuance of the aforementioned authorization to allow the accommodation of the minor in the structure as provided by art. 109 of the Testo Unico Leggi Pubblica Sicurezza, article that provides for the communication of data of all those staying in a hostel - in compliance with a legal obligation - to the Police Station according to the procedures of the Ministry of the Interior.

The processing of data will be carried out with automated and/or paper tools. The personal/identification data of the child will be kept for a period of time not exceeding that necessary to achieve the purpose for which they are collected and kept for ten years following the year of collection, After this period the data will be deleted.
